Period: Follows the contract.

Salary: Minimum 11.697 gross per month (before taxes). The host will provide 3 meals per day at a value of 2400 DKK. House rent is DKK 2.000 per month.

Board and lodging: You will live in your own 10sqm room in the family house on the farm. You will eat all meals with the host family. Internet is available.

Work Offered: You will work with dairy cows and all tasks related to running a dairy production including milking, daily care, feeding, monitoring of the cows, breeding and if capable tractor work and use of mini loader. You work every 3rd weekend.

Your Host Farm: Is situated on a small island called Lyø south of Fynen.

Size: 100 hectares

Live Stock: 65 Jersey year cows (am scaling up to 100 within the next months), 11 Galloway suckler cows, 3 icelandic horses. Average milk yield per cow is 10.600 kg EKM.

Crops: Grass 50 ha, grain 25ha, maize 15ha (for silage) and pasture 10ha

Further Remarks: The farm is run by Bjarne (born 1960) and his wife Karin (born 1963). Their son Laust (born 1996) is also working on the farm. They have all worked abroad themselves for shorter periods. They speak English. They have 3 other children, who are not living at home (1990, 1993,2000).
